Master Class Permission to Miss a Class/Rehearsal

If you, for ANY reason, need to miss a Master Class Class/Rehearsal, you must submit this Permission to Miss a Class/Rehearsal Form as soon as possible.

This form must be submitted at the beginning of the year 2022/2023 if a conflict exists with the school year schedule and calendar. Unexcused absences from Master Class Class/Rehearsal may result in being taken out of Master Class and all Repertoire being set during the 2022/2023 year.

If the student has a "permissible" request, although permission may be granted to miss the Class/Rehearsal, it may require that the student is cast as an understudy or not at all if the conflict is with dress or performance dates.

Your form will be reviewed by the Master Class Committee: Jessica DiMauro Marks, Artistic Director, Annie Doss, Master Class Teacher/Choreographer and Kristina Todd Nelson, School Director. The Master Class Committee has the right to NOT give permission for an absence based on the reason given or importance of the attendance of that particular Master Class or Rehearsal.

Only 2 Excused Absences are allowed in Master Class from September-December, 2022.

NO Absences are Allowed in Master Class from January – April, 2023. If your dancer misses a Class/Rehearsal from January until April 2023 there is the possibility that they will be taken out of the Repertoire and not allowed to perform in the Annual Benefit Performance.
